ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The scope of Modplan Environment Management System(EMS) includes all 4 sites located In Abercarn, near Newport, South Wales, for the supply and manufacture of glazed/unglazed windows, doors and conservatory roof systems fabricated to customer requirements, and a range of Garden Buildings.

Modplan is committed to protect the environment. The businesses environmental impacts associated with our processes have been assessed; and are controlled through implementing our environmental management system and environment improvement objectives. Environment impacts are prioritised based upon the waste hierarchy, Waste Prevention, Re-use, Recycle/compost, Energy recovery, these impacts include

- Prevent pollution at source through engineered controls and workforce training and environmental awareness.
- Emergency environmental controls in the event of an incident, e.g. spill kits
- Ensuring proactive awareness of and complying as a minimum with all environmental legislation, local planning licences and a commitment to maintain neighbourhood relations.
- Increase use of energy efficient processes to reduce tonnage of CO2, which includes investment in higher efficiency equipment, electrical equipment, lighting and controls; planning of vehicle movements with satellite tracking, and fuel efficient vehicles.
- Commitment to maintain the requirements of ISO14001:2015 Environment Management Systems.
- Increase the recycling % of plastic, cardboard, plastic, which currently is above 80%.
- Commitment for an annual reduction in waste sent to landfill.
- Determine and understand the needs and expectations of interested parties.

All at Modplan realise clear communication is vital to ensuring effective environmental management. Environmental improvement at Modplan is a continual process and we are committed to achieving this through yearly environmental objectives.
